

Holito! Native American Adult Dance Intensive at the Georgi on the Battenkill.

Don't miss this wonderful opportunity to learn Native American Dances and Songs from different tribes from across the country. Michael Taylor (Dancing Wolf) is teaching a unique intensive at the Georgi on the Battenkill which will include dances and songs of the Iroquois, Hopi, Inuit, and tribes of the Great Plains.

Michael is Choctaw and French and has been a principle dancer with the Thunderbird American Indian Dancers for 14 years. He has traveled to many areas of the country and brings you first hand experience of the dances you will learn. Included in the intensive is the origins and purpose of each dance, use of the rattle and hand drum, and handouts for each song.

This six-class intensive is open to anyone 15 years of age and older. (Michael will teach a week-long intensive for children 7-12 in July) The current offering will run three weeks on Tuesday and Thursday evenings: 7:00 to 8:30 PM from April 28th through May 14th. There is no prior dance experience required and everyone is welcome. Bring hand drums and rattles if you have them.
