

Archive Search Instructions:

Searches for archive data using Acrobat Reader can be easily expedited. Searches can be made of the data index for items listed in the Table of Contents by title or by using specific key words. The search will then reveal all instances of the title or key word usage in the index. To initiate a search go to the Acrobat Reader Button Bar and locate the Search icon (Binoculars). Clicking on it will open a search screen that is self explanatory. Table contents can also be located by cycling to the designated Index page. See bottom of page. Data can also be located in the Index by searching by Box number from the Table of Contents listing.
